 for the second? 😊 First question ... I still vaguely remembered that a 10er Something port was active, tried it and installed Icinga. After a little research I found the vhost config again and it was clear again how to do it 😊
 -> Before you can log in, you have to set a user using htpasswd, you can also log in to Icinga after installation, but if you enter something / something wrong then the WI says goodbye completely and only one

or a complete restart brings the WI back up.

How did it go now?:
 Under `/etc/httpd/conf/vhosts.d/icinga.conf` you will find the entry

```
AuthUserFile /etc/icinga/htpasswd.users
```

which means as much as that he likes the Auth. File with user name and password would have what but does not yet exist ... So quickly created it would look like this:

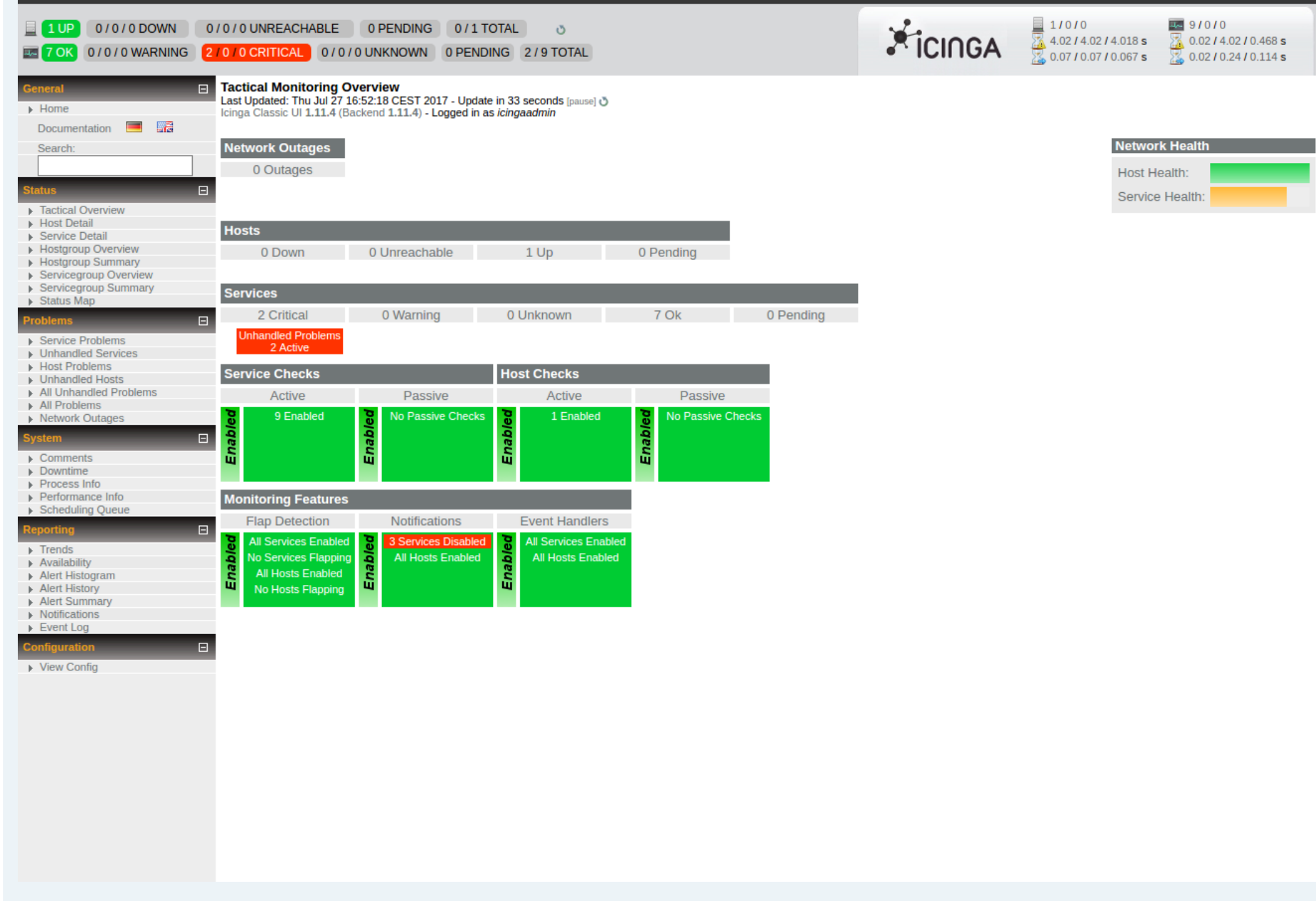

where 'icingaadmin' is the username (logically freely selectable), you then have to enter your password twice, '-c' is needed so that the file is written at the same time ...

typed in and that's it with my "Brain.tar.gz" 😊

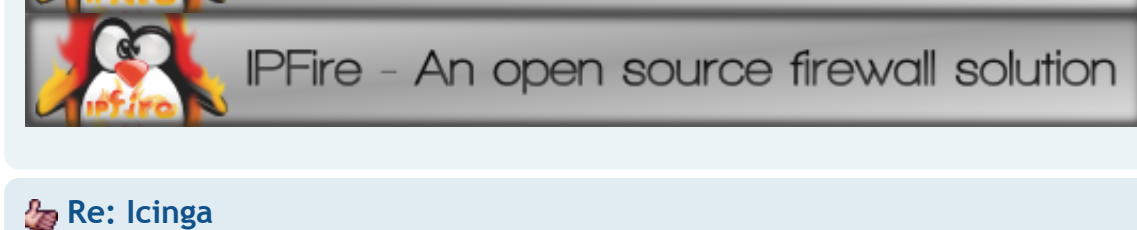


3rd question: I'm just thinking about the build environment.

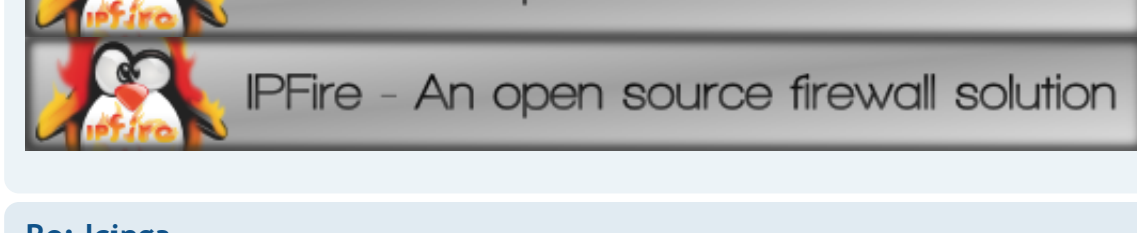

I haven't looked in the post for a long time, but of course that can be done. The only question is, what do you mean by basic config exactly?

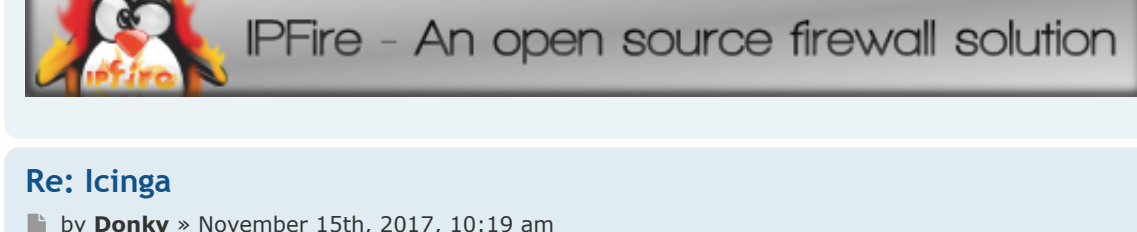
